Chill-Out! Regulations

As a Christ-honouring camp, Chill-Out! seeks to maintain a high standard of Christian conduct. We endeavour to provide an environment that is safe, spiritual, and encourages a respect for others and a closer walk with God. Therefore, any behaviour that is not conducive to this aim will warrant immediate attention by the camp administration, and parents will be notified if necessary.

Preacher's Testimony

Jeff Farnham was raised on a dairy farm in northern Vermont in a non-Christian home — his father an atheist and his mother an agnostic; Jeff never attended church.

Through witness of an underclassman, Jeff was born again October 25, 1974 as a senior in high school. Being convinced early on of the veracity of the King James Bible, of the need to be faithful to God in church, and of the importance of Baptist fellowship, he became an independent Baptist by conviction of the Holy Spirit within the first year of being saved.



Jeff was called to preach on April 4, 1976 and preached his first sermon just one month later. He soon was enrolled in Bible College where he met his future wife, Kathryn. Jeff and Kathryn were married two years later on August 11, 1979.

Pastor Farnham has served as assistant pastor / Christian school administrator (1985-1991) and senior pastor in from 1991 to present.

He has authored four books: The Octopus of Humanism, Rules That Rebels Live By, More Rules That Rebels Live By, and God's Forever Word.

Pastor Farnham has five children: Brad (31), Jennifer (27), Benjamin (24), Bethany (21), and Nathan (17), plus one grandchild, Madison.

THE PACKING LIST

GUYS should wear modest jeans or casual pants for the morning sessions and all activities. Nicer pants and a collared shirt are a good choice for supper and the evening services. Please leave all jewelry at home.
